

AGC Trap League WINTER 2010 Intramurals Rules

AGC Trap Committee

General: This is an AGC club intramural shoot. Although competitors shoot as individuals, scores are averaged with other competitors from the team they represent. Additional recognition for individual scores will be determined by an individual's average score.

Duration: 4 weeks. To start and end on a Sunday. The Intramurals period is: **January 9th – March 6th.**

Registration:

- Only an AGC Club may register.
- All contestants must be a member (in good standing) or spouse/junior of a member, of an AGC club.
- A contestant may register only once to represent only one (1) AGC Club.
- There is a minimum of four (4) contestants an AGC club may register. There is no maximum number.
- There must be more than one AGC club to registered for the Intramurals.
- Each AGC Club may register only once.
- A Club official must register the team by completing and submitting to the AGC Trap Committee the AGC Trap League Intramural Club Registration Form. The Club Registration Form is attached.
- A **\$45** registration fee is required of each adult contestant. Junior's fee is **\$20**.

Record Shooting:

- During the competition period, each contestant must submit, for the record, six (6) scores.
- Only the scores submitted on the official AGC Trap League Intramural Score Card will be counted.
- Any contestant not completing six (6) record scores will not qualify to have their scores submitted for final aggregate scoring.
- All Record Shoots will be 16 yard line, Singles.
- All Record Shoots must be fired on AGC Trap Fields 2 or 3 during Public shoots or properly scheduled Club shoots.
- Contestants may shoot anytime during the competition period. A contestant may shoot all six record shoots on day one, or the last day. There are no restrictions as to when record shoots are conducted.
- A contestant must declare to the Trap Official / Referee running the field, PRIOR to shooting, that "this round of Trap will be a Record Shoot".
- At the completion of the Record Shoot, the Trap Official / Referee will enter the competitors score on the AGC Trap League Intramural Score Card, with date and Trap field number and sign the entry.
- By 1600 hours (or close of Public Trap, which comes first) of the final day of the Intramurals, all scores must be entered on score cards.
- Make-up shoots are not authorized.
- There is no Substitute Shooting.
- All alibis and other issues may be brought to the AGC Trap Committee Chairs for resolution.

Scoring:

- Individual scores are tallied based on the overall average score of each contestant for all 6 rounds of Trap.
- A * (star) value will be awarded to each round with a perfect score of 25 and used to break tie scores with other competitors. Reverse Scoring will be used to break any further existing ties
- Club Scores will be determined by the averaging of all club competitors' averaged scores and adding the * values. Reverse Scoring will be used to break any further existing ties. Lowest competitor score will not be calculated.

Awards: Cash and trophy awards will be given to recognize club and individual achievements.
